



Agreement for Collaboration and Administrative Staff Exchanges on Safety, Health and Environmental Matters between

National University of Singapore acting through its Office of Safety, Health & Environment and

Nagoya University acting through its Environment, Health & Safety Office

The National University of Singapore acting through its Office of Safety, Health & Environment and Nagoya University acting through its Environment, Health & Safety Office, desiring to exchange best practices, programmes and systems between these offices to raise safety, health and environmental standards of the two universities, have agreed as follows:

- 1. The Parties, based upon the principles of respect for each other's independence, University requirements and of mutual benefit, agree to collaborate in the following activities:
 - (1) Study visits and exchange programmes of staff,
 - (2) Sharing of experiences in developing better safety, health and environmental standards,
 - (3) Exchange of publications and documentation on current research,
 - (4) Joint research and other activities within the range of interest of both Offices,
 - (5) Organise joint symposia, workshops and conferences.
- 2. To implement the collaborative activities envisaged under this Agreement, representatives of the Parties may meet periodically to negotiate and conclude specific project agreements and programmes of cooperation, including the terms for their financing, with each other. The financial arrangement relating to each collaborative activity will be in accordance with the specific project agreement and programme of cooperation covering each collaborative activity.
- 3. The Parties agree that in the absence of any specific agreement to the contrary, all expenses, including but not limited to, salary, travel, living and allied costs relating to this Agreement and any collaborative activity thereunder shall be borne by the Party who incurs such expenses.





- 4. All information furnished in relation to this Agreement by one Party to the other, which is clearly identified as proprietary or confidential at the time of disclosure, will be kept confidential by the receiving Party, and will not be disclosed to any third party unless agreed in writing between the Parties.
- 5. This Agreement shall be effective from the date of signature and shall remain in force for a period of 3 years. This Agreement may be terminated at the request of either party with six months' written notice.
